PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The 2018 Graphic Design & Photography Study Tour to Toronto, Canada offers a unique experience for creative art students in Graphic Design and photography mediums. Students will have the opportunity to participate in workshops at Centennial College. They will explore alternative design processes, visit design hubs in Toronto and visit local galleries.

Students participating in this short-term study program will complete the same assessment tasks and activities required of them at TAFE Queensland, and will be granted academic credit upon return to the home institution.

This trip will include studio visits, sightseeing excursions and a day trip to Niagara Falls.

Participating students can expect a unique global study experience, where they will gain industry insights, develop new skills and be inspired by the world around them.
