PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Participants can expect a very unique experience traveling to Papua New Guinea (PNG) learning about the cultural diversity of people living in PNG, their traditions and customs, and learning about the building and construction industry.

This program, hosted by the [Australian Pacific Technical College](#) (APTC), aims to educate students on large-scale joint partnerships between PNG and Australia. Students will visit various construction sites, new housing developments and commercial developments such as;

APEC's building at Ela Beach, Papua New Guinea is hosting the [APEC Leaders' Summit in 2018](#). The annual summit is a regional economic forum to promote growth in the Asia-Pacific region;

The 8 mile housing projects in Edai Town, an affordable housing estate built with Australian joint venture partner [Amode](#); and

The [Curtain Bros](#), a civil engineering and Construction Company operating in across PNG.

Participants can expect to grow their industry networks and gain valuable insights into the building and construction industry.

Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea's capital city and major port, is a vast contrast of the deep blue sea and greenery that surround it. It is known for its Shantytowns that neighbour flashy marinas, for the Ela Beach Craft Market which bring together local artefacts from all over PNG and for its nature park.
