PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Fashion students are invited to participate in a once in a lifetime, faculty led fashion study tour to London.

Purpose of this tour is to provide students with an international experience in Fashion Design and Merchandising and for students to gain new skills and knowledge to complement their learning at TAFE Queensland.

Participants will participate in workshops centred on trend forecasting, sustainable fabrics, embroidery (3D techniques) and London trends at the University of the Arts London (UAL). UAL is an amalgamation of a number of prestigious fashion and design colleges in London, including Central Saint Martins.

This tour will include organised visits to the Victoria Albert Museum, the world's leading museum of art and design as well as the Fashion and Textile Museum, a cutting edge centre for contemporary fashion and textiles in London (\$18 Entry Fee not included in program fees).

Amongst workshops at UAL & exploring Fashion & Textile Museums there will be opportunities to visit Harrods in Knightsbridge, Hyde Park, and celebrated fashion houses in Mayfair.

PROGRAM COST INCLUDES
