PROGRAM OVERVIEW

In this short-term study tour students will participate in workshops centred on community outreach at an elite North American college. Canada is a leader in Community Development practices. This opportunity is for students to meet with practitioners and community members in order to supplement their learning.

Purpose of this tour is to provide students with an international experience in community development and to gain new skills and practices to implement at home.

Example workshops at Centennial College;

- Skills to work with groups experiencing marginalization
- Skills and understanding of social justice, anti-oppressive practice, sustainable development, community engagement, community asset-mapping, fundraising, team building & collaborative leadership.
- Understanding of the issues faced by community development groups and insights into initiatives used by community development groups in Toronto

This program includes a sightseeing excursion and a day trip to Niagara Falls.

Participating students can expect a unique global study experience, where they will gain industry insights, develop new skills and be inspired by the world around them.

PROGRAM COST INCLUDES
